Rationale / Justification

- Designed to move WLN into a new decade, based on existing multisectoral network development / strength and experience (in the 1st decade).
- Thailand's potential contribution, especially as host to APEC Technology Foresight Centre and experiences on e-Thailand Graduate Institute of Science and Technology (TGIST, e-Learning module) and other similar e-Network programmes.
- Creation of Leadership Development Support System under the Framework of APEC 2006 Theme (ICT Capacity Development – Sub theme I)

Objective & Goal

- An innovative HRD support system that allows broad participation of member economies and covering multi-sectoral interests (government, business, academic and NGOs)
- Strong women leadership in member economies and the APEC region, with emphasis on young Leadership

Strategies and Approach

- Member economies are invited and encouraged to jointly plan, design and develop an e-Leadership Development Training Network (e-WLTN) and joint development modules. (Virtual Training Centre).
- APEC – endorsed feasibility study project is initiated, by Thailand and interested member economies (on a voluntary basis).
- APEC Technology Foresight Centre, in cooperation with Thai University Groups on Women Studies, serves on the (Study) Project Management Team with the selected experts from member economies serving as resource persons.
